Ribbon Yarn Scarf

This easy, reversible pattern shows off ribbon yarns beautifully.





Materials Needed

2 skeins (50g each) <u>Moda Dea Ticker Tape</u> yarn (shown in Festival) 1 pair US size 13 (9mm) knitting needles **or** whatever size *you* need to achieve the necessary gauge

Gauge

12 stitches = 4 inches (10 cm) in garter stitch

Finished scarf measures 5" wide and 58" long (13cm x 147cm)

Instructions

Cast on 15; knit 3 rows. Begin pattern stitch:

Row 1: k1, *yo, k1; repeat from * across. You now have 29 stitches on the needle.

Row 2: Knit across, dropping the yarnovers. Now you are back to 15 stitches.

Rows 3-5: Knit

Repeat these 5 rows until scarf measures 48" (122cm), ending with Row 5 of pattern. Bind off.

Fringe:

Cut 24 lengths of yarn, each 10 inches long. Attach 12 fringes to each end. For each fringe, fold one length of yarn in half. Pull the fold through one stitch on the short end of the scarf, making a loop. Thread the ends of the yarn through the loop and pull to tighten.
